In total, the North Denmark ICT industry numbers around 8.200 jobs and a great number of companies. Among the companies in North Denmark are branches of Intel, Samsung Denmark Research Center, WiSpry, Tunstall Healthcare, Keysight Technologies, Mediatek, Novo Nordisk, Nokia Solutions and Networks Danmark and Litepoint, in addition to Danish world-leading companies TARGIT, EMD International and GomSpace.

Companies benefit from the long history of close collaboration between the ICT researchers and students at Aalborg University – the leading ICT university in Denmark – and local and global industry.

Company facilities are easy and comparably cheap to rent in North Denmark, including in the NOVI business and research park in Aalborg, and wages are often lower than in for instance the Copenhagen area.
